## ADMISSION TO MBBS, B.Sc Nursing & B.Tech COURSE UNDER NRI QUOTA 2011-2012

### INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. Admission will be made in the Co-operative Medical College, Kochi and in the following Engineering Colleges under the Co-operative Academy of Professional Education (CAPE) to the NRI quota seats for MBBS, B.Sc Nursing & B.Tech Degree Courses with specialisations shown against each college, for the academic year 2011-2012.

2. The **Application Form** obtained from any one of the above colleges/CAPE office at Thiruvananthapuram/ downloaded from CAPE website/photocopy shall be used.
3. Eligibility will be the qualifications as prescribed in the prospectus for admission to professional degree courses issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE), Kerala 2011/relevant Govt. orders/admission rules of CAPE which made applicable for admission to NRI quota and subject to the regulations of the University where the college is affiliated, and also subject to the rules relating to age limits and medical standards. The candidate

should be a child/ward/dependent of an NRI and he should enclose with the application, a declaration from the NRI in the form mentioned below.

4. Declaration from the NRI to be enclosed with the duly filled up application form:

Copy of any one of the following documents duly attested by a Gazetted Officer of Central/State Govt. to prove the NRI status should be enclosed with the application form .a)copy of the employment certificate b) copy of the relevant pages of the passport containing visa details c) Certificate issued by a Scheduled Bank stating that he/she is a Non-Resident Indian holding an NRI account other than a Zero balance account.

5. Fees will be as prescribed by Government/CAPE. Admission will be made by the Director of CAPE through a centralised process.
6. Fee structure shall be as prescribed for NRI seats in the self-financing Engineering and Medical colleges under CAPE and subject to further decisions of the Management of CAPE. The candidates are required to remit the prescribed fees and deposit at the time of admission as Demand Draft drawn on SBT in favour of the Director, CAPE payable at Thiruvananthapuram. Fees once paid will not be refunded. However those candidates who get admission in Government Colleges and in Government quota seats in Government-aided colleges will be refunded with the fees after deducting an amount towards admission and processing fee as per the rates fixed by CAPE.
7. Sending an application by itself does not confer any right on the applicant for making any claim for admission.
8. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he has indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he shall be expelled from the educational institution.
9. Any student who discontinues his/her studies and leaves any college under the CAPE, after closure of admission to that college, is liable to pay the entire tuition fee for the remaining years of the course and the Transfer Certificate will be issued to him/her only after compliance with this condition.
10. In addition to the annual tuition fee, special fees as applicable will also be payable at the time of admission.

11. These instructions form part of the Notification No. **1811/A/2010/CAPE**, dated: 16.04.2011, inviting applications for admission to MBBS, B.Sc Nursing & B.Tech degree courses against NRI seats in the Medical, College of Nursing and Engineering Colleges under the CAPE. The admission to the colleges under the CAPE will be governed by these instructions and conditions and also such other rules and regulations that may be issued in this regard.
12. The Application Form should be filled up carefully furnishing the entire information called for. If the results of the qualifying examinations are not declared, the space for marks may not be filled up which shall be furnished later.
13. The candidate can indicate his/her choice for courses in the order of preference at Sl.No.1 in the Application Form by using the **course** details given against para (1) above.
14. The candidate should also enclose the true copies, **duly attested by a gazetted officer**, of the documents against (1) to (4) of Item No. 11 in the MBBS application and 12 in the B.Tech application form.
15. The completed application together with a registration fee of Rs. 1000/- for MBBS. & Rs.600/- for B.Tech, B.Sc Nursing by D.D. drawn on SBT in favour of The Director, CAPE payable at Thiruvananthapuram and with supporting documents should reach the **DIRECTOR, CO-OPERATIVE ACADEMY OF PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION, 1<sup>st</sup> FLOOR, COBANK TOWERS, VIKAS BHAVAN P.O., THIRUVANANTHAPURAM-695033** not later than **26-04-2011**. The candidates, at their own interest, are advised to send the applications by Registered Post. **CAPE cannot be held responsible for non-receipt or late receipt of applications, under any circumstances.**
16. Incomplete applications and applications not in the prescribed form will be summarily rejected. Late applications will be considered only if vacant seats are available after the seat allotment.
17. Without prejudice to the directions of the Government of Kerala / University where the colleges are affiliated and MCI / Nursing Council of India / AICTE as the case may be, CAPE has absolute powers to decide on all matters and its decisions shall be final.
